## **Sharing and Serving**

There are needs being identified amongst our neighbors in the community. Do you know someone who lacks food in the community? Please considering using or sharing information about the following:

- Food collection is happening in two ways. We are collecting food for the Herkimer Food Pantry. Pasta (boxes of pasta or macaroni/cheese mixes), cereals or any canned foods are appreciated at this time as there is a shortage. Drop donations off safely by adding them to the box, located either at the side door of the church or on the Parsonage Porch. JoAnn Blaise delivers our donations each Monday afternoon. Rebecca (Becky) Walrath is collecting donations for the Frankfort/Ilion Food Bank. For more information, call or text Becky at 315-868-7673. Leave a message if she doesn't answer.
- We continue to **provide meals** for the people who come to the **Salvation Army on the third Friday of every month.** These meals are now created to be "taken out". Please understand that meals that were provided throughout the community on a regular basis are now NOT being provided in all places.
- *Feed My Sheep* meals continue to be provided to the community. 48 were made over the past few weeks safely and with physical distancing being maintained.
