# A Message from Trinity's Church Council

Trinity's Council has prayerfully decided that we are ready to try returning to in-person worship for ONE service on September 27th at 10 am. Trinity's Council will then assess the experience and make plans for the following weeks. We also plan to broadcast that service by Zoom and FaceBook, as we have been doing, to reach all members of the congregation.

We share in the responsibility to keep one another safe in these uncertain times. You wear a mask for the sake of your neighbor and they for you. The keys to safe gathering are small numbers, physical distance, masks, and self-policing. We are capable of all 4 of these.

Masks will be required by those attending the service, and all Covid-19 safety procedures will be followed. It is necessary to reserve a seat for this service so that we can comply with group size. Please remember that if you have signed up, and discover you are unable to attend, please call Judy. We will then be able to offer your seat to someone from the "waiting list." To sign up to attend in person, please call Judy Sadlon at 315-429-9575.

There will be another opportunity for us to gather and receive Holy Communion with Dean Gail on Saturday, September 12th at either 10am, 10:45am, or 11:30am. Dean Gail will be present at Trinity to preside at 3 short services of Holy Communion which will be held in the Fellowship Hall and limited to 8 individuals each. Seats at the tables will be marked off; please go directly to your seat and wait for the whole group to assemble.

Only 8 people (of all ages) will participate in each of the 3 gatherings. You MUST register ahead of time so there is no overflow and so that we can trace who was present. Reservations will be taken on a first come, first serve basis. Please call Judy Sadlon at 315-429-9575 to reserve your spot. Once again, we ask that if you discover you are unable to attend, please call Judy. Then we can offer your seat to someone from the "waiting list."

Please do not come if you are experiencing any symptoms (cough or fever, or have been exposed to the same). **MASKS** are required. Hand sanitizer will be available at the entrance. Dean Gail will be the only person handling the communion elements. The surfaces will be cleaned between each group.

You will enter through the Henry St entrance and exit using the driveway door. The service will be 15 minutes and will include a short reading, the Communion liturgy and prayer. The bathrooms will not be open. The elevator will be available.

#### BLESSINGS OF PRAYER:

"Do not worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with Thanksgiving let your request be made known to GOD. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your heart and your mind in Christ Jesus." Philippians 4:6,7

### PRAYER NOTES

There are two words often overlooked in the lesson about prayer that Paul gives us in Philippians 4:6,7. They are WITH THANKSGIVING.

In approaching God to ask for new blessings, we should never forget to return THANKS for blessings already granted. Returning THANKS for blessings already received increases our faith and enables us to approach Jesus with new boldness and new assurance. As we reflect upon the wondrous goodness of God towards us on the one hand, and on the other hand upon the little thought and strength and time that we put into THANKSGIVING, we may well humble ourselves before God.

Jesus is our model in prayer as in everything else. We find in the study of His life that His manner of returning THANKS at the simplest meal, was so noticeable, that two of His disciples recognized Jesus by this after His resurrection. (Luke 24:13-31)
