# The Lenten Season Begins - Remembering Our Baptisms

You are receiving this issue of the Glad Tidings a few days earlier than usual, because **Lent begins with Ash Wednesday, on March 2nd** this year. Lent is a season in which we are reminded of our mortality beginning with Ash Wednesday as we are marked by dust and ashes. Though we contemplate our mortality on Ash Wednesday, this day is a beginning too, of a season of returning to our baptism. Our theme for Lent this year is "Remembering Our Baptisms".

The Worship and Music Committee wants to provide a variety of Ash Wednesday experiences for you and your family. Trinity will offer a **virtual** Ash Wednesday service led by Pastor Wolling. The virtual service will be available on the Trinity website, Facebook, and our YouTube channel beginning on March 2nd. The service can be accessed at any time convenient for you and your family.

Inside your Tidings envelope you will find a bag of ashes for your use if you choose a virtual experience. Prior to watching the service, please mix the enclosed ashes with one small drop of olive or vegetable oil. You will then be ready to make the sign of the cross on your forehead or the back of your hand when prompted during the worship service you are viewing. The following prayer has also been written for you to say out loud or in your heart during the service.

Almighty and everlasting God, you hate nothing you made, and you forgive the sins of all who are penitent. Create in us new and honest hearts, so that, truly repenting our sins, we may receive from you, the God of all mercy, full pardon and forgiveness through your son, Jesus Christ, our Savior and Lord who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen

If you prefer an **in-person experience**, please join our Lutheran friends at either **Zion (New Hartford)** or **Our Saviour (Utica)** at their services. Ash Wednesday services will be offered on March 2 at 12:00 pm at Zion (Distribution of Ashes together with Holy Communion, led by Deacon Patsy Glista), or at 7:00 pm at Our Saviour (Distribution of Ashes together with Holy Communion, led by Pr. Anita Mohr).

### What is Lent and Why Does It Matter?

The season of Lent is a time of spring cleaning, cleaning out the old in order to begin anew. It beckons us to splash in the waters of baptism. At Trinity, during Lent we will place the baptismal font near the entrance of the sanctuary. Please take a moment to pick up and take home a glass stone to remind you of the waters and blessings of your baptism, when you were given the identity of God's child and the presence of the Holy Spirit.

Martin Luther once said," Everytime you wash your face, remember your baptism". Whether you are with us in person or attending worship virtually, we invite you to place this quote by your bathroom mirror during the Lenten season. Each time you splash the water, remember the promises of your baptism.

We will also be reposting the virtual midweek Lenten services by Rev. Gail Wolling from last year with the theme "Season of the Heart."

# BLESSINGS OF PRAYER .:

The primary purpose of prayer is to bring us into a life of communion with GOD the FATHER that, by the power of the HOLY SPIRIT, we are increasingly conformed to the image of His Son, JESUS CHRIST.

# PRAYER NOTES .:

"Lord teach us to pray" (Luke 11:16)

Q: What is the difference between repetition prayer and persistent prayer?

A: Concerning prayer, Jesus said: "But when you pray, do not use vain repetition as the heathen do, for they think that they will be heard for their many words." (Matthew 6:7). Notice that Jesus instructs against vain repetition. God does not want us to pray mechanically or insincerely. This should not be confused with regularly praying over months or years about something of concern to us.

Persistent prayer, from the heart, is the subject of the parable of the unfortunate widow (Luke 18:1-8). If even an unjust judge will take action because of the persistent request, how much more will our righteous, just and loving God do? God hears our sincere, persistent prayers and will answer them in due time and in accordance with HIS WILL.

This month, please pray for the newly baptized in Christ Jesus. Pray that the Holy Spirit would place in their hearts a deep desire to seek the Lord their God, as they continue to grow in their Faith journey with Jesus. AMEN

## **Trinity Lutheran Church Draft Covid 19 Protocols**

Using the NYS Department of Health Guidelines and Herkimer County data, the TLC Church Council has set the following expectations in place for anyone using the church facilities. This includes worship, meetings, and all other purposes.

## When the County rate of infection is **High or Substantial**:

- Wear a mask, except when seated and consuming food/beverage in the Fellowship Hall or communing. Masks must be worn correctly.
- Sign in on the chart when you enter the church, at the bottom of the stairs.
- Maintain a comfortable and safe distance between yourself and others (six feet).
- Stay home if you are not feeling well or have any symptoms of illness.
- Use good hygiene practices, including use of the hand sanitizing stations provided.
- Respect one another at all times.

### When the County rate of infection is **Moderate or Low**:

- Unvaccinated individuals must wear a mask at all times.
- Masks, worn correctly, are required for vaccinated individuals while singing during worship, or singing anywhere in the church building.
- Sign in on the chart when you enter the church, at the bottom of the stairs.
- Maintain a comfortable and safe distance between yourself and others (six feet).
- Stay home if you are not feeling well or have any symptoms of illness.
- Use good hygiene practices, including use of the hand sanitizing stations provided.
- Respect one another at all times.

The county rate is measured weekly, and we share the rate in our Weekly Announcement email. In addition, a sign is posted on the church door to state the risk level of our county. Masks are available to those who are in need.

If we all follow these guidelines, our church will continue to be a welcoming and safe space, both virtually and physically. Thank you for being a part of Trinity!
