God turned the sea into dry land, so that they went through the water on foot, and there we rejoiced in God.


Ruling forever in might, God keeps watch over the nations; let no rebels exalt themselves.


DIALOGUE

INVITATION TO COMMUNION


In Christ's presence there is fullness of joy. Come to the banquet.
