Zion, New Hartford, is also working on preparing their MSP, and Our Saviour, Utica has joined the conversation regarding sharing a Pastor to serve our Congregations.

More future planning to discuss: a Nominating committee is to be formed to prepare for January's Annual Meeting in 2024. Wendy Catera has agreed to run for election to the Council seat she was appointed to fill until the Annual Meeting, which will be a 2-year term. Two Council seats will be up for 3-year terms of election/re-election, which Phillis Becker and I currently occupy. The Endowment Committee has current members Mike Marusic, John Sadlon, and Deke Pollak who are eligible to run for another term, with election/re-election also to be done at the Annual Meeting in January. If you would like to volunteer to run for election, or to be on the Council or Endowment Committee, please speak to any Council member. Council has not yet set up a Nominating Committee.

Worship, Music, and Prayer

BLESSINGS OF PRAYER:

"If My people, who are called by My Name, will humble themselves and pray and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and forgive their sin and will heal their land." (2 Chronicles 7:14)

PRAYER NOTES: A guideline for focused daily prayer:

Monday: PRAY FOR YOUR FAMILY BY NAME: Pray that God will bless, guide and keep them, meeting them at their point of need, drawing them one step closer to Jesus Christ.

Tuesday: PRAY FOR GOD'S FAMILY: Pray for the body of Christ. Start with the local body, your church. Pray that The Gospel is proclaimed as "FIRST importance", as stated in 1 Corinthians 15:1-11. Keep on praying for all the saints (Ephesians 6:18).

Wednesday: PRAY FOR YOUR COMMUNITY: Who is my neighbor? someone asked Jesus. The Lord responded with the parable of the good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37) "What happens to you matters to me". This should guide our prayers for people in our communities-those we live with, work with, bump into, see at the store, and the list goes on.

Thursday: PRAY FOR YOUR NATION: A most fitting prayer to pray on behalf of the nation is to adapt to the Lord's words as stated in (2 Chronicles 7:14).... a good verse to memorize!!!

Friday: PRAY FOR THE WORLD: Pray for the worldwide outpouring of the Holy Spirit, and thus a vibrant body of Christ being used by God to help the people. Why? "To know Christ and to make Him known."

Saturday: PRAY FOR THE SICK, HELPLESS, HOPELESS, HURTING AND LOST: Start with the world, draw closer to your nation, state and closer still to your own community. List the names, praying for those physically and spiritually affected. Pray that the Lord would use you and your family to help meet the needs of the "LEAST OF THESE".

Sunday: PRAY FOR PERSONAL GUIDANCE: "Do you not know that those who run in a race all run, but only one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may win," said the apostle Paul (1 Corinthians 9:24). Pray that God would help you to run for the prize in every area of your personal life.

Come join the community of faith by taking part in Trinity's prayer chain. The only requirement is a heartfelt willingness to bring the concerns and needs of others to Jesus. Remember to learn to pray is simply to pray.
