One of my favorite songs is <u>Multiplied</u>, by the band, Need To Breathe. The lyrics form a prayer:

Your love is like radiant diamonds / Bursting inside us--we cannot contain. Your love will surely come find us / Like blazing wildfires singing Your name

God of mercy sweet love of mine / I have surrendered to Your design. May this offering stretch across the skies / And these Hallelujahs be multiplied.

It's an ideal song for the offering in worship, but lately I've been hearing it through the lens of the offering that is you. Not your time or talent or treasure. Each of you. All of you.

My installation on May 3rd was a deeply spiritual experience for me, and I think, for all who were able to be present. From the moment when we chose the date, I said to Justina, "I want all the kids to lead this one. This is my fifth installation, and I've never had it led primarily by children and youth. Can we make this happen?"

Justina sent out Save The Date cards to all our families. We hoped to have practice on Friday night. And because of other obligations, including sports commitments to their respective teams, only 2 students were able to come to the installation.

Until the morning of May third. And then, very early in the morning, while it was still dark, it began to rain. And by breakfast time, the games were canceled. And once the children no longer had commitments to their teams, they all came. And even more, they wanted to come. They showed up early. We trained them each as they walked in the door. And by 9:30, students were at the doors handing out bulletins, greeting people, welcoming. Children were trained as acolytes. Young readers were ready, having practiced multiple times. Big kids were paired up with younger ones to collect the offering. And we began the service with our youngest members meeting me at the font where we spontaneously improvised a sports-like huddle, putting our hands together in the water and raising them up as one.

It was holy, and hectic. Hallelujahs were multiplied.

Thank you all for the energy and generosity you brought to this occasion, and to all that you continue to bring in your commitment to the body of Christ. Not one detail was overlooked. And the leftovers from the scrumptious food fed 26 unhoused families in Utica. It is a blessing to be your pastor. I can't wait to see how God's love comes and finds us over and over again as we walk this road together. You. And me. And all the children. Hallelujah!
